A Sample Prayer for Your Husband

Lord there are so many things I want to pray for my husband because my heart is full of love for him and concern for him as a person, as my husband, as the head of our home and as the father to our children. Not only does he need you to guard his heart and his mind and lead him in every way every day I need you to please work in his life as well because it effects my life and our children. I ask that you please protect him from the lies of the enemy and close his ears and heart to those lies. Help him to discern what is coming from you and what is coming from the enemy and to bring his every thought captive to your will.

I want our marriage to honor you. I pray that you will please protect our marriage from all sexual sin and impurity. Please remove anyone or anything that will be a temptation to my husband or that threatens to come between us and destroy our marriage.

Please guard my husband's heart and mind. Help him to bring every thought captive to your will. Let his words be pleasing to you. Let him only speak words that build up and encourage his family and not tear them down. Guard his heart and help him to love his family the way you love the church. Let him place you as his first priority in his heart and life. I know that when he is living his life for you, according to your will and putting you first then everything else will fall into place including me and our children.

Let my husband be a man of integrity and a good reputation. Help him to understand how important it is for me and our children to be able to respect him so that we can honor him as we should.

Father I pray that you will help him to be the father that you have called him to be. You say in your word that children are a blessing from you and I pray that he will understand that and be thankful. Let him never take his family for granted. Help him to set the example to our children of a man who loves you, serves you and honors you. Help him to love his children like you love us, unconditionally. Let his children know that no matter what and even when they make mistakes their father still loves them. Help him to be quick to forgive because you forgive us. You say in your word that if we don't forgive others then you will not forgive us. Sin separates us from you and having unforgiven sin keeps us distant from you.
